

# PASSPORT INFORMATION

The City of Coconut Creek City Clerk's Office (954-973-6774) is an official Passport Acceptance Facility and accepts Passport Applications at the Government Center, 4800 West Copans Road, during the following hours:

**Monday and Tuesday - 2:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m.**

**Wednesday and Thursday - 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.**

## ALL APPLICANTS MUST BE PRESENT TO SUBMIT APPLICATION

### THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS ARE NEEDED TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION:

1. **Passport Application** - Complete using black ink pen only. Do not sign application until requested to do so by acceptance agent.
2. **One (1) passport photo**, 2" x 2" in size. Specific instructions are included in Passport Application. **NOTE: The City Clerk's Office does not take passport photos.**
3. **Proof of U.S. Citizenship:** Original birth certificate or certified copy from vital statistics with seal, previous U.S. Passport, or Certificate of Naturalization if applicable.
  - Hospital birth certificates are **not** acceptable.
  - The aforementioned original document **will** be mailed to the Department of State with your application and is mailed back to you separately from the issued Passport.
  - Our office is not permitted to make copies of these official documents.
4. **Valid photo identification** (Driver's License, Government-issued Identification card. Learner's Permits require an additional form of identification)
5. **Payment of Fee – see below**

Passport Applications for Minors – **Proof of parental relationship (birth certificate) even when renewing. All applicants must be present and both parents are required to execute a passport for any minor under 16 years of age.** Written consent from an absent parent is acceptable but **MUST BE NOTARIZED and a photocopy of the government issued identification (front and back) must be submitted.** Additional documents may be necessary.

### FEES FOR PASSPORT BOOK:

#### **Adult Passport Fee: (16 years of age and over)**

\$110.00 application fee payable to the U.S. Department of State (**CHECK OR MONEY ORDER ONLY**); \$25.00 execution fee payable to the City of Coconut Creek (check, cash, credit card or money order accepted)

#### **Child Passport Fee: (15 years of age and under)**

\$80.00 application fee payable to U.S. Department of State (**CHECK OR MONEY ORDER ONLY**); \$25.00 execution fee payable to the City of Coconut Creek (check, cash, credit card or money order accepted)

#### **Expedite Fee:**

To receive your passport within 10 to 14 working days, add a \$60.00 fee to each passport application fee listed above.

## **PASSPORT CARDS**

The U.S. Passport Card can be used to enter the United States from Canada, Mexico, the Caribbean, and Bermuda at land border crossings or sea ports-of-entry and is more convenient and less expensive than a passport book. **The passport card cannot be used for international travel by air.**

### **FEES FOR PASSPORT CARD:**

#### **Adult Passport Card Fee: (16 years of age and over)**

\$30.00 application fee payable to the U.S. Department of State (**CHECK OR MONEY ORDER ONLY**); \$25.00 execution fee payable to the City of Coconut Creek (check, cash or money order only)

#### **Child Passport Card Fee: (15 years of age and under)**

\$15.00 application fee payable to U.S. Department of State (**CHECK OR MONEY ORDER ONLY**); \$25.00 execution fee payable to the City of Coconut Creek (check, cash, or money order only)

### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

Passports take approximately 4-6 weeks to be mailed to you. See paragraph above for information regarding expediting the process. Persons planning to travel within 14 days or less **MUST** make an appointment with Miami Passport Agency. Call (877) 487-2778. Be prepared to provide proof of travel.

You may check the status of your passport application by going to the U.S. Department of State web site: **travel.state.gov**. Click on "check the status of your passport application online" and follow the directions.
