


Access the City's **GIS on the Web** interactive mapping application (shown below) by going to <http://coconutcreek.net> →

Then, zoom-in to the area of interest and follow the 5 steps shown below:

STEP 1: Choose the Identify tool while the map redraws

STEP 4: Display the directory of scanned files by clicking on the link for your chosen project. Both Utilities & Engineering as-builts and Planning & Zoning site plans are available for online viewing

STEP 2: Set the selection layer to: Communities/Projects

Map Tool Options
The current cursor mode is set to 'Select/Identify'. Click on a map feature to select it. Clicking on a map feature that has already been selected will unselect. Dragging on the map will create a window that selects multiple features. Use the drag select for better accuracy when selecting points. The selectable theme can be set to the right.
