

## Standard Banner Mounting System for Commercial Properties



### Notes:

- Mounted banner height shall not exceed 6'-0" in height above grade.
- Maximum banner width is 8'-0"
- Maximum banner height is 4'-0"
- See detail at right for V-shaped installation
- Banners must be sized to fit mounting system without sagging or bunching.
- Minimum 5' setback required. See Zoning Department for location criteria.

### Optional 3-pole Installation

Note: Interior angle not to exceed 90 degrees.
