



EXTENDED HOURS APPLICATION

CODE SECTION - Sec. 14-28. - Construction activity.

- (a) It shall be a violation of this section for any person to do, perform or engage in any exterior construction work, building, excavating, hoisting, grading, pile driving, pneumatic hammering, demolition, dredging, building alteration or repair work of any nature to any building or structure or upon any site for same in the city except between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Saturday and 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Sunday and national holidays.
- (b) Any person desiring to engage in the aforesaid activity beyond the stated hours or days of limitation, based upon cases of urgent necessity or upon the interests of public health, safety and ultimate convenience, may apply to the city manager or a designated city employee for a special permit allowing same. Such permits if granted shall be limited to a period of up to ten (10) days duration, but may be renewed for additional periods of up to ten (10) days each if the emergency or need therefor continues. In the issuance of such permits the city manager or the designated employee should weigh all facts and circumstances and should determine whether the reasons given for the urgent necessity are valid and reasonable, whether the public health, safety and ultimate convenience will be protected or better served by granting the permit requested, and whether the manner and amount of loss or inconvenience to the party in interest imposes a significant hardship. Upon an affirmative finding of the foregoing considerations, the city manager or a designated city employee is authorized to issue the permit request. This permit may be reviewed when the activity exceeds seventy-five (75) decibels when measured at fifty (50) feet from the construction site. A violation of this section shall cause immediate revocation of the special permit.
